
Reply Ontions



Productivity tip - Use of "Cntrl +A" and then Spacebar to choose all items in a prompt picklist #workdayhacks

In talks with a few others in the Workday Community, I noticed that there is a handy option for choosing items from a pick list on a prompt that some folks are not aware of.

The context would be any prompt box which gives a list of options with a checklist next to each one, where you want to select all or most of the items in the pick list before submitting the prompt.

I am attaching a PDF file that shows three examples of the use of this technique. However, the same technique should be able to be used anywhere there is a pick list that allows a multi-instance selection.

My IE and Chrome is locked down from any password or username saving. I use batch files and function keys to copy to my clipboard and then I paste my usernames and passwords.

More advanced automation can be done with this but it is enough for what I need.

You can use any location to create and save these files I used Desktop as an example.

Summary (Shortcut key runs a .bat file that copies the text in a .txt file to your clipboard that can then be pasted)

- 1. Open New Notepad
 - Type only your password or username

Friends, Community and Countrymen -

Sometimes it tests our patience to keep seeing the mouse icon rotating as Workday keeps searching for the report field that we want to use in a condition rule, per se.


Fastest method for adding that calculated field would be to get its Workday id via the field's related action, and then search for the WID in Source Field.

Voila, if the field's business object is supported by the BP condition rule, you need not wait. It works like a charm.


To generalize, searching by WID searches at speed of light.


- How can I use "Workday ID" in searching and why is it so fast?
 - "wid:" search prefix (bypasses all search indexes and goes straight to the instance identified by the WID)
 - Global search



- Search within dialog boxes
 - Example: Find the exact right field very quickly

Productivity Enhancement - Easy way to facilitate "Search by Workday ID"

I would like to resurrect the general concept of an earlier Brainstorm idea (HERE) that was closed due to low votes and see if there might be the possibility of getting some more traction for this concept. I find the technique of being able to "Search by Workday ID" very useful while working in different areas of Workday administration and configuration and believe that this concept would be very useful to other customers and partners as well and improve their efficiency in various administrative and configuration activities, including report and calculated field development and maintenance.

It is difficult from the outside to truly know the level of development effort required to add one related action feature on the drop down menu of objects (i.e. like "Favorites > Add"); but from the outside looking in, it seems like this should be a fairly easy lift from a development standpoint and provide a feature that would help improve efficiency across the application.

I am attaching a PDF file that explains the general concept I am thinking of.

In general, I am looking for new option that would be available on the related actions menu under the search category of "Favorites" for "Copy WID Search", which would copy "wid:" + the Workday ID of the object to your clipboard. You could then use that value for any "direct seaches" to get directly to that object.
