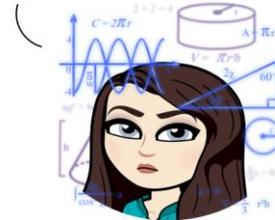
I work in Higher Education/Government. I've been using Workday since before our deployment in 2017.

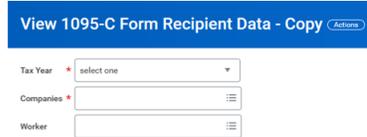


ACA Reporting is everyone's favorite time of the year, right? Here are some tips to make your reporting as painless as possible!



My best advice: Copy the delivered report "View 1095-C Form Recipient Data" and add additional fields:

- Unmasked SSN
- Benefit Group
- Position Information
- Hire/Termination/Retirement Dates
- Calculated fields to display information about the most recent job change

Export your ACA 1095-C Form Data Report to Excel, then Filter, but DO NOT SORT!

Tip: Look at any employees who transferred between your companies or had a benefit group change mid-year.
